ACE High School is a Career Technical Education (CTE) high school for those motivated students who are interested in highly technical and skilled career pathways. Eligible students in grades 9-12 will have the opportunity to learn high school academics through a combination of high school classes, CTE college credit classes, dual credit, and middle college classes towards earning their CTE high school endorsed diploma and technical certificate. Students seeking technical certifications may take college classes at the TMCC William Pennington Applied Technology Center during their 10th-12th grades in dual credit and middle college programs offered through ACE High School. Most students' core high school academics will be taken at ACE's Vassar Street campus. All 9th grade students will spend their first year on campus while 10th -12th graders may have their CTE/college classes at TMCC's Edison Campus or ACE's construction site.

11th & 12th GRADE ACE HIGH SCHOOL/TMCC MIDDLE COLLEGE COURSE INFORMATION

Eligible 11th and 12th grade ACE students, for the 2019-20 school year, that are interested in taking courses via the ACE/TMCC Middle College Program please continue reading this flyer.

ACE/TMCC Middle College allows ACE students to take any Applied Technology Courses at TMCC's Edison Way campus as long as the student is eligible and the course will fit into their ACE schedule, typically that means the course is offered between 12pm-10pm M-F or on weekends. GPA requirement for eligible Seniors is 2.5, and for Juniors is 3.0. Student must have exemplary attendance and behavior.

Students can earn credits toward certifications in the following areas listed on the back of this form. All credits can be applied to a two-year Associate Degree. Courses are taught by TMCC instructors. Please go to TMCC.edu; College Catalog for more information about a particular course of study and to view classes that may be offered:

STUDENTS INTERESTED IN THE MIDDLE COLLEGE PROGRAM, FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS BELOW:

1. Read through the certificates on page 7.
2. Go to TMCC.edu, search the certificate name and research the requirements of the certificate. ACE CANNOT provide you all the information you need, you MUST do research on your own. Feel free to meet with Mrs. Jonas if you have questions after you do your research.
3. If you would like to enroll next year, go to page 7 and **WRITE YOUR NAME and GIRGLE or HIGHLIGHT the Certificate Program** that you are interested in pursuing. This class will be in addition to your career class at ACE. ACE will determine eligibility and course availability outside the ACE regular scheduled day. If eligible, you will be enrolled in the appropriate course sequencing for the program. You will have an opportunity to confirm your registration prior to the start of school.

How to read the back of this page:

- Each certificate is listed with the number of credits and the number of courses the student must take to earn those credits.
- Students will not take more than 2 courses at a time.
- Some programs are self-paced, (P3, Welding) therefore students can earn credits at a rapid pace. However, they must meet deadlines that are established for completion. They can move quickly through a certificate, but they can't go slower than required.

Please note the following:

- Not all courses are offered every semester
- Some courses offered conflict with the ACE High School schedule and are not available
- ACE pays tuition; however, if a student fails the course the tuition costs must be reimbursed to ACE
- Students are responsible for textbook and equipment fees. For example, the Welding program requires approximately \$200 of equipment (hood, leather gloves, etc.)
- ACE provides one bus run to TMCC at 12:15. ACE does not pickup from TMCC for Middle College Programs
- There is a high demand for HVAC Technicians and Panasonic P3 completers; therefore, these programs have excellent employment opportunities.
- This program is NOT designed for students to dabble, it is designed for students who are serious and intentionally seeking certification in a specific area.
